Notes:

If you have already installed the ATS EFlash Programmer software and just want to update the JToolbox and the manufacturer's download links document, follow these instructions. If you are installing the ATS EFlash Programmer for the first time, follow the instructions that came with the product.

These instructions assume that you are using Microsoft Internet Explorer. If you are using Firefox or another browser there will be differences from the screens shown here.

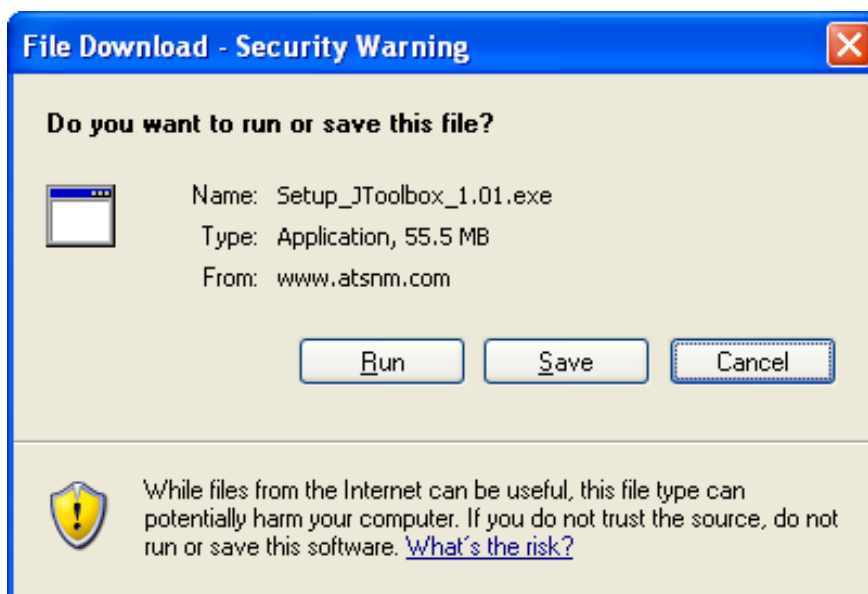
Also, these instructions assume that Java and Adobe are already installed and that you don't want to reinstall these programs. However, there is no harm in reinstalling Java or Adobe if you wish.

REGISTRATION:

In order to receive technical support you **MUST** register your products. Your information will be kept on file and referenced before any support is administered. DOWNLOAD THE JTOOLBOX SOFTWARE:

1. Click on the download link for the JToolbox on the Automotive Test Solutions web site: <http://www.atsnm.com/downloads.htm>.
2. When the download starts, click on **Save**.

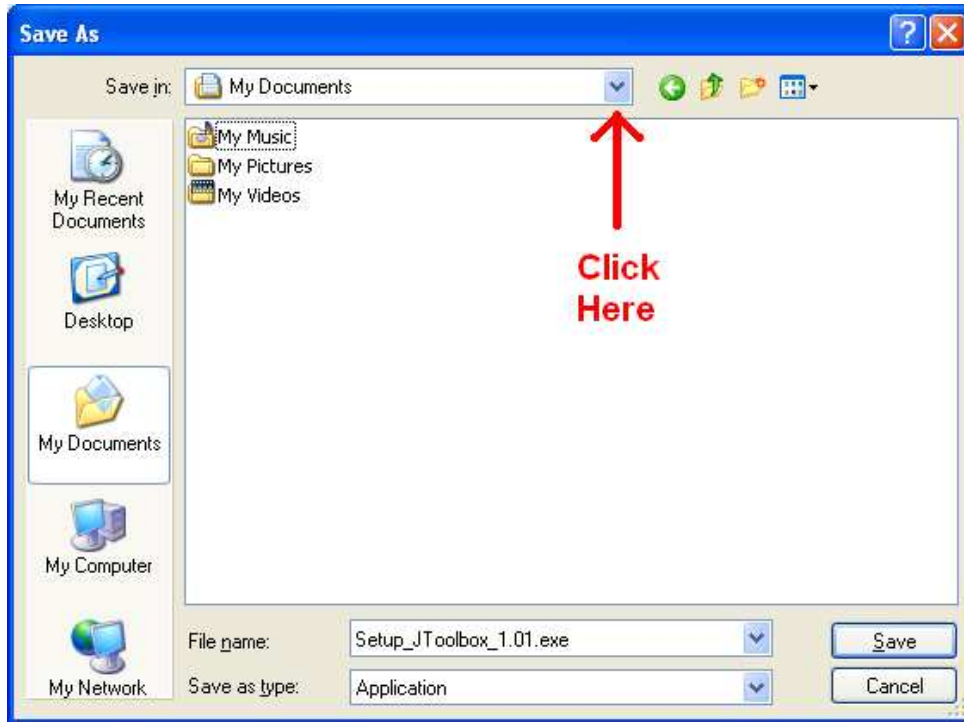


Note: Your screens may look slightly different from those shown here.

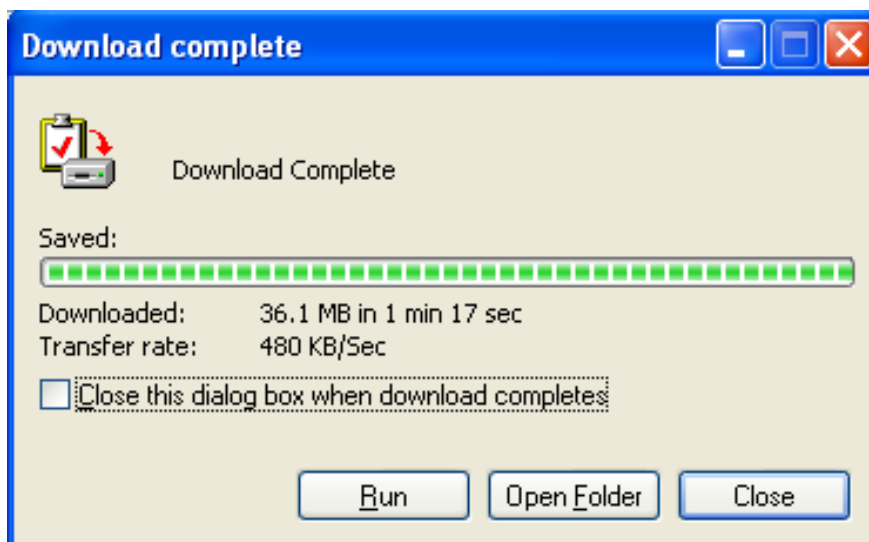
If using Windows Vista, proceed to step 18.

If using Windows XP continue here:

3. On the “Save As” window, click on the down arrow for “Save in” and navigate to “My Documents” as shown below.

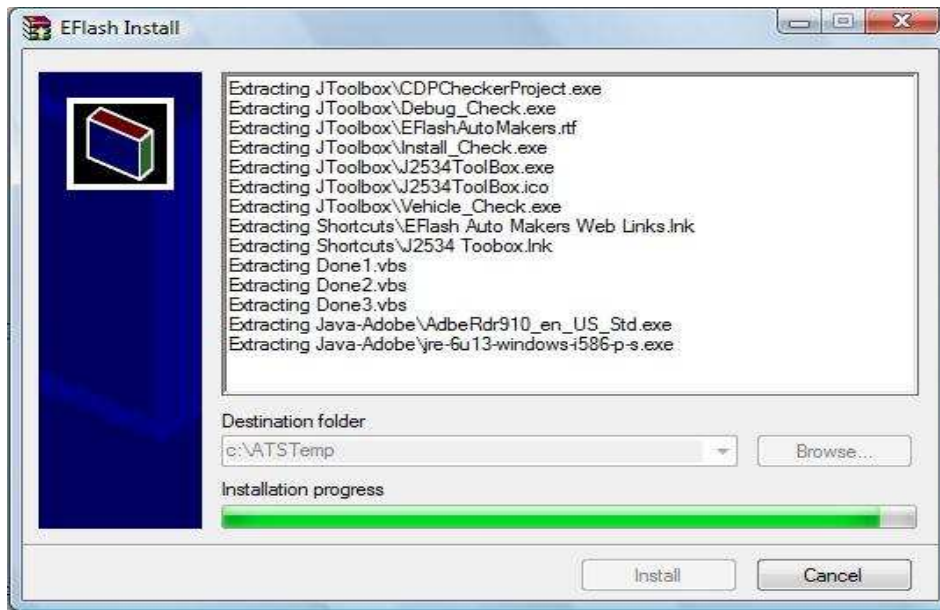


4. Once “My Documents” is displayed in “Save In:”, Click **Save**
5. At this point the download will start.
6. When the download is completed click on **Run**.



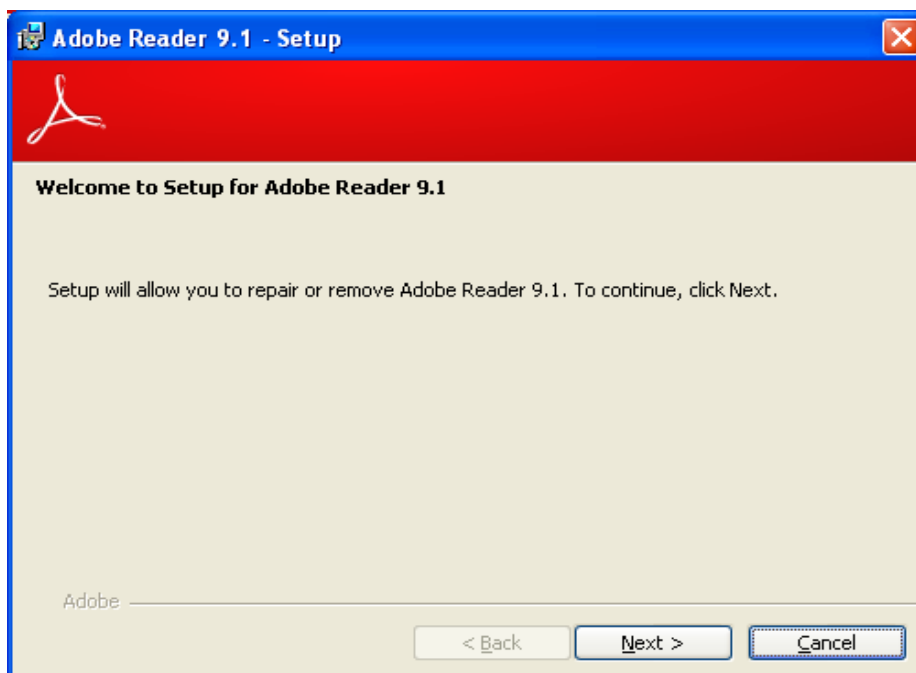
7. Click **RUN** on the security warning.

8. At this point you will see the “self-extracting” window:

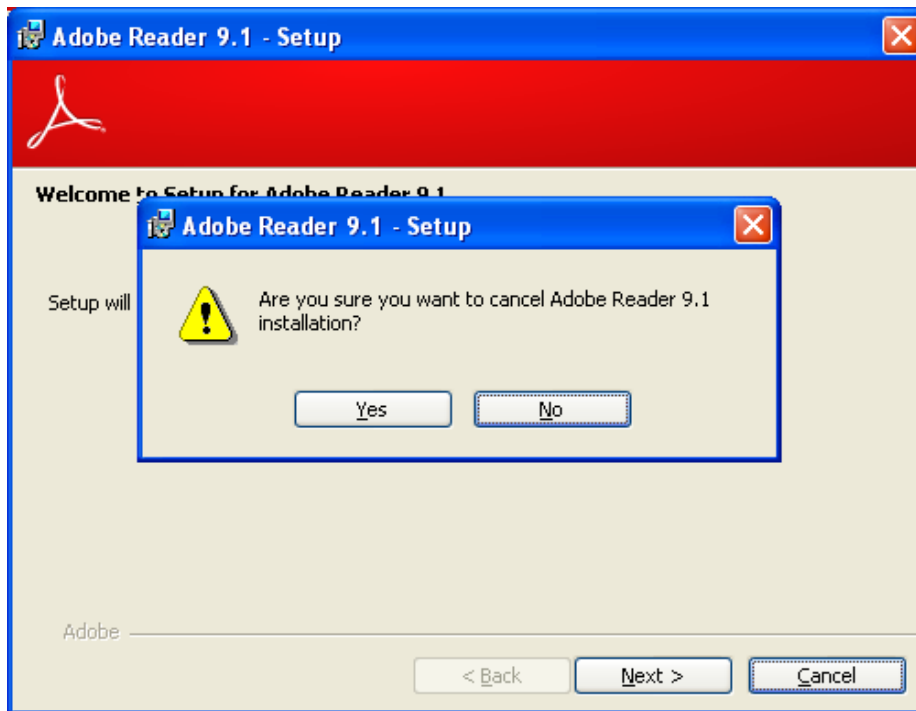


9. After the “self-extracting” window closes, click **OK** on the welcome screen.

10. Adobe Reader will start to install. If you see this screen, then Adobe is already installed. Click **Cancel**.



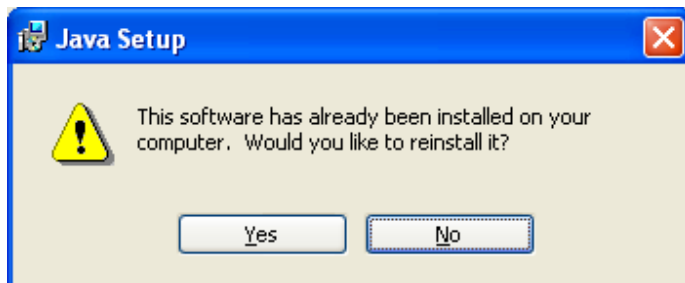
11. Next you will see:



12. Click **Yes** and then **Finish**.

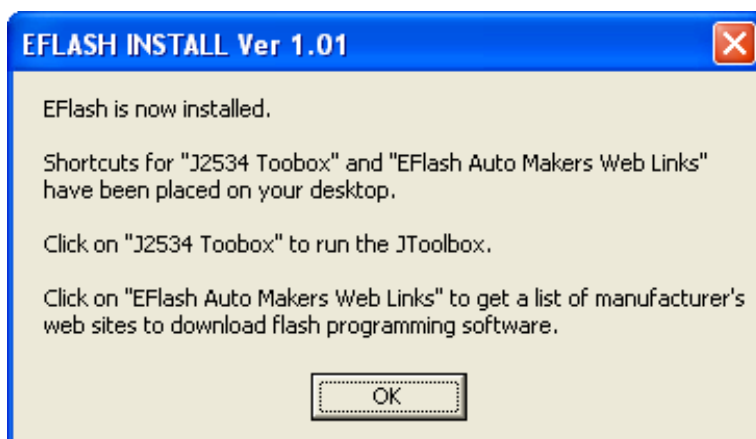
13. Now Java will start to install.

17. Click **OK**.

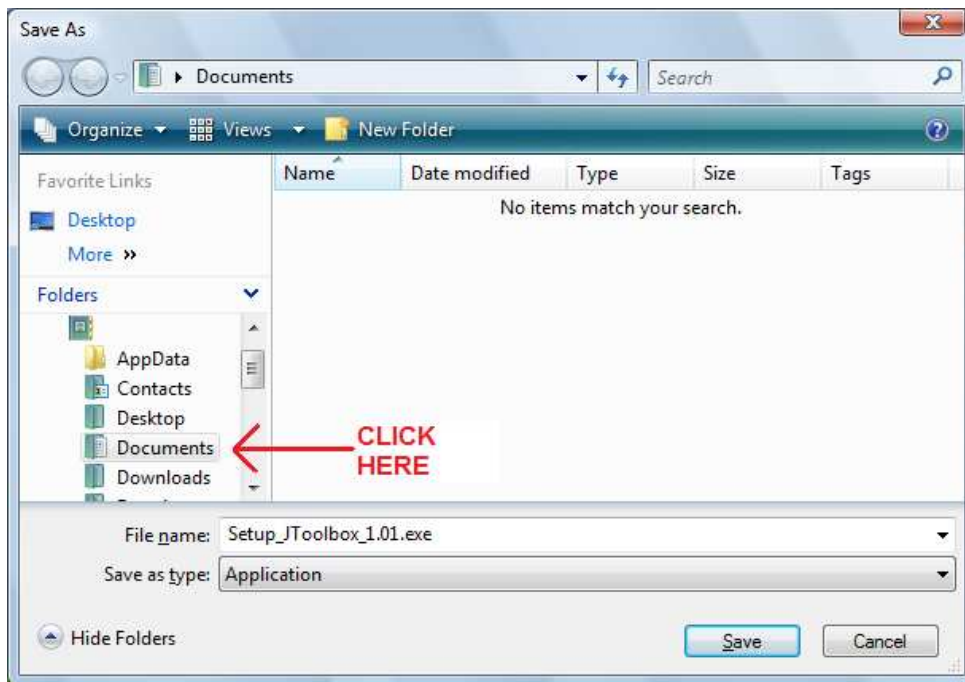
If using Windows XP, proceed to step 36.

If using Windows Vista, continue here:

18. On the “Save As” window, click on **Browse Folders** (if needed) to show the “Folders” display.

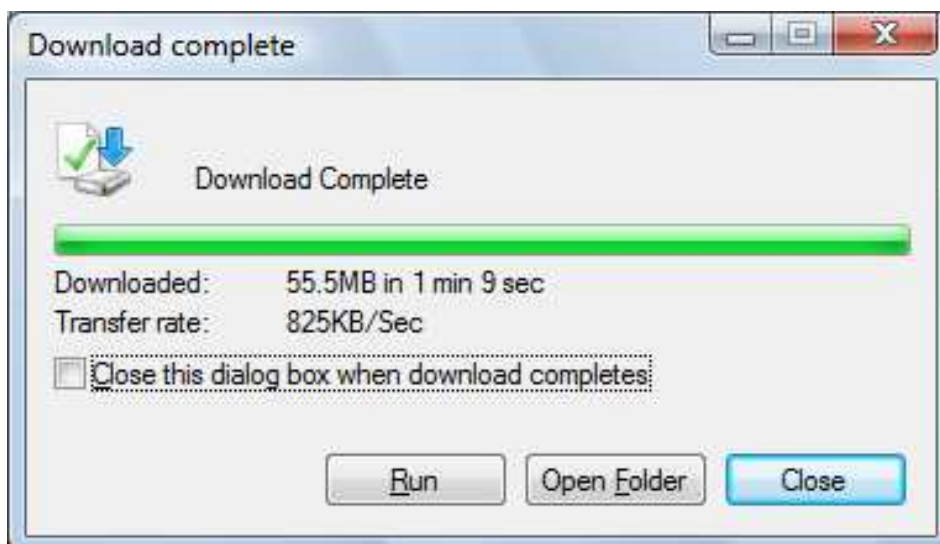
19. Click on **Documents** to select the Documents folder.

20. Once “Documents” is highlighted in “Folders”, Click **Save**.



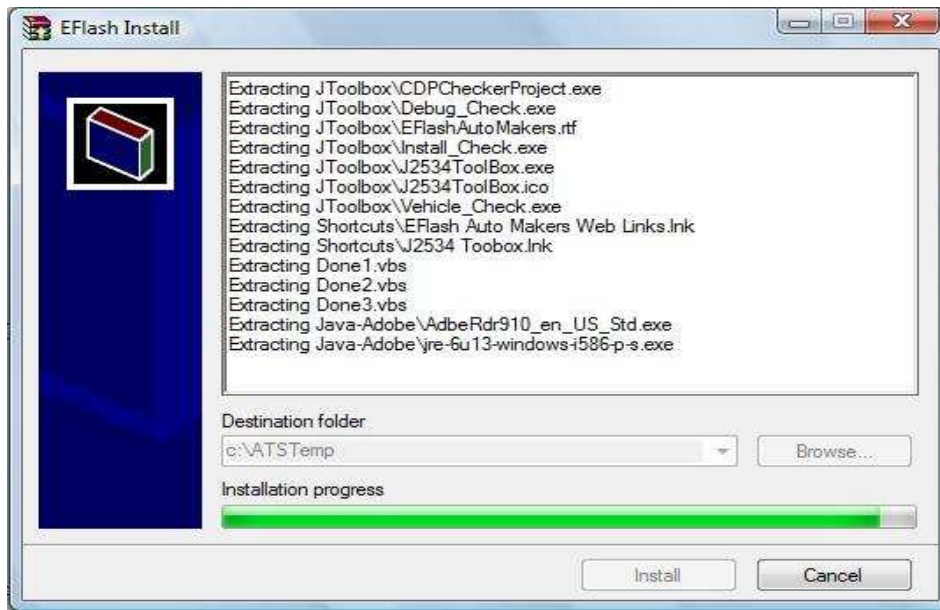
21. At this point the download will start.

22. When the download is completed click on **Run**.



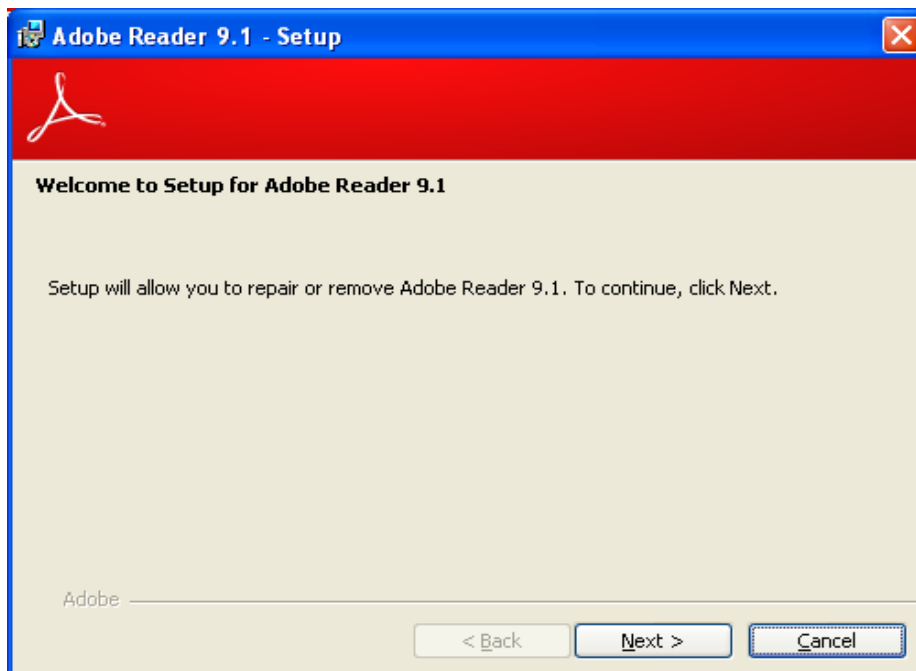
23. Click **RUN** on the security warning.

24. At this point you will see the “self-extracting” window:

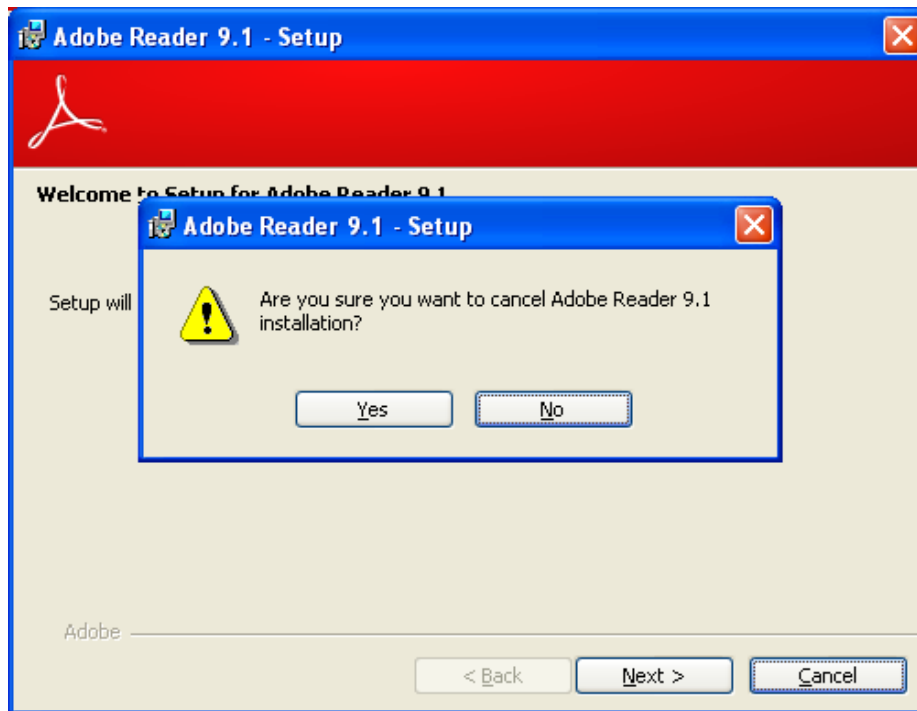


25. After the “self-extracting” window closes, click **OK** on the welcome screen.

26. At this point Adobe Reader will start to install. If you see this screen (asking about “repair” or “remove”), then Adobe is already installed. Click **Cancel**

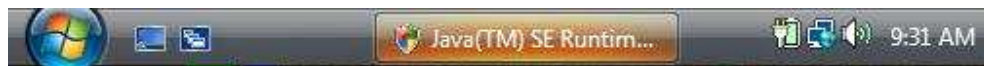


27. Next you will see:



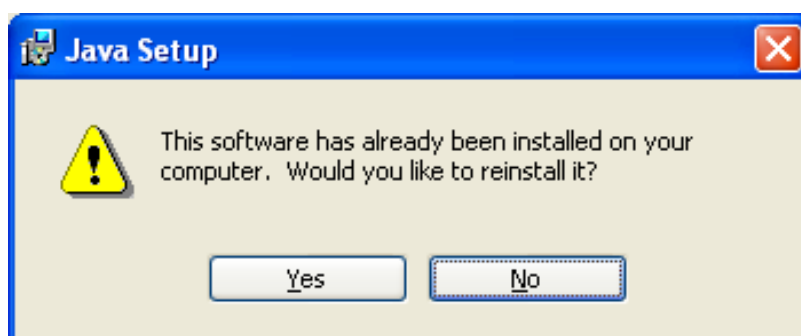
28. Click **Yes** to cancel the Adobe install.

29. Following this, click on the flashing **Java (TM) Runtime** on the Windows task bar and then click **Continue**.



30. Now Java will start to install.

31. If Java is already installed, this you will see:

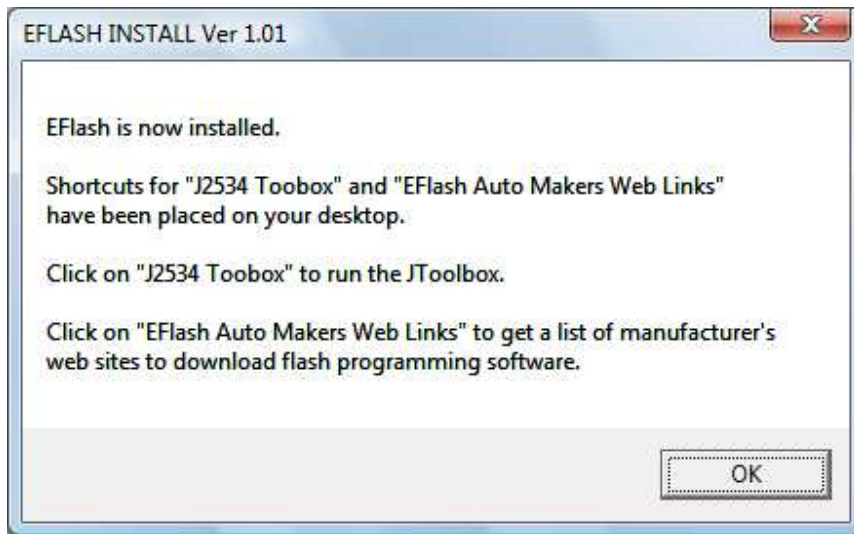


32. Click **No** to cancel the Java Install.

33. Click on the flashing **Microsoft (R) Windows** and then click **Continue**



34. After a few moments, you will see:



35. Click **OK**.

36. JToolbox is now updated.

37. To run the JToolbox, on the desktop double click **J2534 Toolbox**.

38. To access the automotive manufacturer's flash software, on the desktop double click **EFlash Auto Makers Web Links** to get a list of web sites that offer subscription software.

If you have an internet security program like "Norton Internet Security" it may warn you that the J2534ToolBox.EXE program is trying to access the internet the first time you run it. If this happens tell the security program to unblock the EScan Pro J2534ToolBox.EXE program.
